## 7. Cookies and similar technologies

### 7.1. *The use of "cookies"*

When visiting the websites and/or the participants platform, 'cookies' may be left on the hard drive of your computer or mobile device. A cookie is small text file that is left by the server of a website in the browser of your computer or on your mobile device when you consult the website. The cookie contains a unique code that allows it to recognise your browser during your visit to the website (a so-called 'session' cookie) or on subsequent, repeated visits (a so-called 'permanent' cookie). Cookies may be left by the server of the website you are visiting or by partners with whom that website works together. The server of a website can only read the cookies it has left itself. It does not have access to other information on your computer or your mobile device. Cookies are stored on your computer or your mobile device in the folder of your browser. The content of a cookie usually consists of the name of the server that left the cookie, an expiry date and a unique numerical code.

Generally speaking, cookies facilitate and accelerate the interaction between the visitor and the website, helping the visitor to navigate between the various parts of a website. Cookies may also be used to render the content of a website or the publicity on a website more relevant for the visitor, adapting this to his individual tastes and needs.

Other technologies are also used for similar purposes as cookies on other platforms where cookies are not available or cannot be used, such as the advertisement ID that is used on mobile Android devices.

## **7.2. Which kinds of cookies exist?**

First party cookies' are technical cookies that are used by the visited site itself. Their purpose is to ensure the site delivers optimum performance. For example: settings made by the user on previous visits to the site, or preloaded forms with details completed by the user on previous visits.

### *7.2.1. Necessary cookies*

These cookies are indispensable to be able to visit websites and to be able to use certain parts of websites. These cookies allow you to navigate between the various parts of the website for instance, or are used to fill in forms. Refusing these cookies means some parts of the website will not work or will not work to their full potential.

### *7.2.2. Functional cookies*

Functional cookies are the cookies that facilitate the performance of our websites, giving you a more pleasurable and more personalised experience. These are the cookies that remember your preferences for instance.

### *7.2.3. Performance cookies*

This website also uses Google Analytics. Cookies are used to gather information about the kind of use visitors make of our websites, with the aim of enhancing the content of our websites, bringing them more in line with visitors' wishes and raising the ease and convenience of use of our websites. For example, there is a cookie that helps us count the number of unique visitors and a cookie that keeps track of which pages are most popular.

### *7.2.4. Third party cookies*

Third Party cookies are cookies that are not left by the website itself, but by third parties, for instance via a marketing or advertising plug-in. Examples include cookies from Facebook or Google Analytics. For this type of cookies, visitors first need to give their consent. This consent is sought via a bar at the bottom or at the top of the screen, with reference to this policy. Refusing such cookies will not hamper your continued visit to the website.

The websites and/or the participants platform also contain elements from other, third parties, such as video services, social-media buttons or adverts.

### 7.3. *Changes to browser settings*

You can set your Internet browser so that it will not accept cookies, give you a warning whenever a cookie is being installed or for the cookies to be deleted from your hard drive after you have left. You can do so by going to the settings of your browser (use the help function). As you do, bear in mind that certain graphic elements may not display correctly, or you may not be able to use certain applications.

You can refuse or delete cookies via the browser settings on your computer or mobile device. The way in which this is done may differ from one browser to the next. If need be, consult your browser's help feature. The following settings should be set separately per browser and per computer:

Social media and other websites use information about their users' web surfing behaviour to serve them targeted publicity. To stop being tracked for targeted publicity, you can sign out for targeted adverts via the opt-out website of the European Interactive Digital Advertising Alliance ([www.youronlinechoices.eu](http://www.youronlinechoices.eu)), or for the U.S.A. via the opt-out website <http://www.aboutads.info/choices/>.
